

CAMBODIA QUICK FACTS

Cambodia's economic freedom score is 57.8, making its economy the 105th freest in the 2019 Index. Measures to modernize commercial codes and facilitate private-sector development have been implemented in recent years. All sectors of the economy are open to foreign competition and investment. Labor force participation is high. The combined value of exports and imports is equal to 124.9 percent of GDP. The average applied tariff rate is 9.8 percent. As of June 30, 2018, according to the WTO, Cambodia had one nontariff measure in force. New foreign investment may be screened by the government. Privatization has gradually improved financial-sector efficiency. Banking has become more market-oriented, with credit increasingly available to the private sector.

CAMBODIA ECONOMIC UPDATE MAY 2019


Preliminary estimates for Cambodia show real growth achieved a four-year high of 7.5% in 2018, compared to 7.0% in 2017.

The economy performed better thang expected, driven primarily by rapid expansion of exports and robust internal demand, as well as a surge in Foreign Direct Investment.

With better-than-expected export performance, the growth outlook has been revised upward, compared to earlier projections.
